

**SnowPlow Sam 1-3:** These are entry level classes which have been specifically designed for children under the age of five. The most elementary skating skills are combined with fun and games in order to capture and retain the children's attention and concentration.

**Basic 1-6:** Classes designed for skaters ages 5 & up and Tots who have passed SnowPlow Sam 3.

**Pre Freestyle (Pre-Requisite = Basic 6):** Class combining U.S. Figure Skating Basic 7 and Basic 8. In this class, skaters learn several turns and glides that must be mastered prior to learning jumps and spins.

**Freestyle 1-4:** Classes designed to give a skater a strong foundation on which to build their figure skating skills. Each level includes skills of spinning, jumping and moves in the field.

**Hockey 1-4:** Classes designed for skaters ages 4 & up, interested in hockey and have passed Basic 2. Skaters will learn the fundamentals of hockey skating with emphasis on the development of skating skills and physical strength. No sticks or pucks needed.

**Tot Hockey:** For the pre-school age child who can't wait to begin his/her hockey career. This class combines beginner skating skills along with basic hockey skills to motivate the child and help them learn to skate. Sticks and plastic pucks may be brought to this class.

**Parent/Tot:** Relaxed class for parent and child to learn skating basics and play together. One parent per child only.

**Adult:** Classes for ages 18 & up designed to meet the needs and goals of the beginning adult skater.
